

You travel through Western Canada with a motor home. Experience Alberta from the prairies to the Rockies, learn about the history of settlers, cowboys and native people. In British Columbia enjoy the drive through lake lands and try some wine in famous Okanagan Valley. The last days you spend at a wilderness lodge in the Kootenay Rockies where you experience nature and take part in native rituals.

Itinerary

18 days/17 nights or 21 days/20 nights

Option 1:

Day 1: Calgary

Arrival at Calgary Airport. You take a cab to the hotel and later, you have enough time to stroll along downtown and Bow River.

Option 2:

Day 2: Calgary Stampede

You're invited to attend the largest outdoor rodeo in the world! Professional cowboys compete in a myriad of rodeo events, including bull-riding, chuckwagon racing, steer wrestling, barrel racing. Don your western duds, saddle up, and join us for Stampede breakfasts galore, square dancing, parades, the fun of the midway, great exhibits, a spectacular Grandstand Show and fireworks, and, of course, heapin' helpings of Western hospitality.

Day 3: Calgary Stadt und Abendshow

Visit Glenbow Museum with its various exhibitions – especially have a look at the First Nations exhibition.

In the evening at 8:00pm you have tickets for the chuck wagon race and evening show with fireworks.

Day 4: Heritage Park

Exprience Calgary 150 years ago. At Heritage Park you travel back in time and learn all about Calgary's spectacular history.

Day 5: Pick up Motor home - Waterton NP - 260 km

Today you pick up your motor home in Calgary. Before leaving for Waterton National Park, you pack your motor home with groceries. Overnight in Waterton Lakes for 2 nights.

Day 6: Waterton NP

Boat tour on the lake or hiking to Crypt Lake.

Day 7: Waterton - Kootenay ca. 400 km

You drive through the Rockies to Kootenay Country. Enjoy the scenic route from Kootenay Bay to Nelson. Camp in the area of Nelson.

Day 8: Kootenay - Okanagan Valley 300 - 350 km (depends on campground)

Continue the picturesque drive back to the mountains – from green vegetation down to Okanagan Valley. Overnight near Osoyoos, e.g. at the Nk'Mip Indian reserve campground.

Day 9: Wine tours in Okanagan Valley

Okanagan Valley has the best wine in British Columbia. Visit the different winery and do some tastings.

Day 10: Wells Grey Provincial Park

The journey takes you along Okanagen Lake, Kelowna and Kamloops to Clearwater. You stay for 2 nights at Wells Grey National Park and visit different waterfalls in the area or you can go on a canoe trip on Clearwater Lake.

Day 11 - 12: Jasper National Park

We cross fingers that you can take a beautiful picture of Mount Robson on the way to Jasper National Park. Usually it is covered in clouds. In Jasper enjoy tours and attractions such as Maligne Lake – Spirit Island – and Maligne Canyon.

Day 13: Columbia Icefields – Rocky Mountain House

Dirve along scenic Icefield Parkway Highway to Columbia Icefield. Don't miss a tour by snowcoach on top of the icefield or book a helicopter flight! Continue to Rocky Mountain House. Overnight.

Day 14: Trochu

It's time to get to know the "other" Alberta. Overnight at a campground along Red Deer River near Trochu. (Toleman Bridge).

Day 15: Drumheller & Dinosaurier

The area is famous for its dinosaur fossils . Visit Royal Tyrrell Museum where you can learn all about it! Another attraction are the so called Hoodoos that are close to Drumheller. Overnight in Drumheller.

Day 16 - 20: Calgary - Kootenay Rockies

You drop off your motor home and pick up your rental car.

Spend the next days at a remote wilderness lodge in the Kootenay Rockies. Go on a canoing, rafting, hiking and get to know the traditions of Native people.

Day 21: Calgary - Abflug

You drive back to Calgary and drop off the rental car at the airport. You fly back home.
