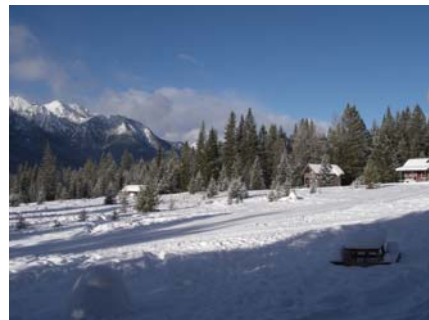
Ski and other winter activities in several resorts of the Rockies

Discover lesser-known gems of the Rockies: explore Kananaskis Country on snowshoes with your Métis guides who will tell you fascinating stories about the past and the first explorers in the Alberta Rockies, about the traditional uses of plants and will teach you how to recognize and understand animal tracks in the snow. Or/And a dog sledding expedition will give you wonderful opportunities to help harnessing the dogs and to drive your own sled with the assistance of your guides while enjoying the quiet beauty of the Spray Valley.

An ice walk in the Grotto Canyon will bring all the fascination of ice formations and pictographs. Learn about the meaning of the drawings, why they are there, who may have left them behind and who for sure did not.

Then you go off to a cozy wilderness lodge in the Kootenays with its luxury cabins, cozy fireplace, sauna and hot tub, where your guide takes you on snowshoe or ski hikes to tranquil forests to track coyotes, lynx, cougars, wolves, arctic hares and deer.

Enjoy different ski areas of the Rocky Mountains, in the Wilderness of the Kootenay Rockies, in the Purcell Mountains.
